

Section F – Hi-Lo Doubles Tournament

On Sunday at EVERY All-Star Series of Darts Weekend.

Team Cap... This event has no team cap is available to all sanctioned players including non-all star caliber players from fully sanctioned PPD members and all skill levels of players from associate level PPD sanctioned members. The Hi-Lo is a flighted event. Flights will be determined after all excepted entries are paired up highest and lowest, then separated by the total team Point Per Dart. Any player who ***IS NOT QUALIFIED for the Sunday All-Star event*** may register for the Hi – Lo Doubles except, the Finale (effective 2011), where any player who ***IS NOT INVITED to the Sunday All-Star Finale*** may register for the Hi – Lo Doubles.

Entry Fees... \$20 per person. Players register as individuals, we will assign partners as described below. Fees are non-refundable. Entry fees are due at the time of submission. Entry is not confirmed until the entry fee is paid, at which time the entry will be posted “confirmed” on the web site. Beware – checks must clear prior to the 2 week deadline. Make checks payable to All Star Series of Darts. Money orders are accepted, same as cash. Credit cards via PayPal are also accepted (plus fees).

NOTE: *Because this event is held on Sunday and starting after the main All Star Men’s and Ladies events; dartboard space is limited by the number of boards potentially still in use for the main event competition. Thus, Hi-Lo entries are limited to the first 128 players; to allow for two (2) brackets of 32 teams, totaling 64 teams which will require 32 boards in the first round. As the Series goes forward, the Hi-Lo registration restrictions are subject to change up or down depending upon the total dartboard counts in comparison to the number of All Star expected. First come first served. Sign up early to ensure your opportunity to compete in the Hi-Lo.*

Partnering Process... All participants are assigned a partner based on a high-and-low pairing of their history/current/tournament PPD – *whichever is highest*. Example: the highest PPD player will be assigned the lowest PPD player, the second highest with the second lowest et cetera until all teams are set, then the teams are flighted with the highest 32 teams by total team PPD in the Gold flight, the second highest 32 teams in the next flight etcetera.

WARNING, Subs may be used if available: Should any player fail to show we do not re-draw teams, we may replace/substitute a missing player with the closest ranked player available, except that the ranking of the substitute must be lower than the person that is missing, if such a sub is available. Worst case scenario; if there are no subs available the team will become a bye. There are no refunds because payouts are calculated at registration deadline. If a player is left unable to play due to a no-show partner and no sub scenario, that player will still receive the 4 bonus points, where applicable.

Payouts & Bonus Points... 100% payback, based on full flight of 32 teams.

Event Check-In begins at 11:00 am... players are required to be at the tournament site, identify themselves and receive name tags by ***11:45 am deadline***. Tournament will start as soon as everyone has checked in or by ***12:00 pm at the latest***.

Format – Added matches on Winners Side...please see Section A for complete details.

Triple Elimination – Winners Side will be a race to two, 501/Cricket/501; Survivors Side will be a race to two, 501; Losers Side will be ONE (1) game of 701. Game format is on all score sheets.

Shooting Order...Lowest to Highest – Player B (the corker), Player A
