Section A – General Tournament Rules

Who Is Eligible... Any player who meets the age specific requirements for their operator and who has an established History Marks Per Round (MPR) and Points Per Dart (PPD) is eligible to compete in the Singles, Triples, Mixed Doubles and Handicapped Team Events. Any player who has participated in at least six (6) weeks of league and has played a minimum of 24 games of Cricket and a minimum of 30 games of X01 (50 point Bull) will establish a History MPR/PPD. For players whose History MPR/PPD is derived from less games than the player has in a current league, the higher of the two MPR/PPD's will be used for sign-up purposes.

As time passes, sanctioned players who have competed in prior All-Star Series of Darts tournaments will also establish a tournament MPR/PPD, which will be used if higher.

For sanctioned players of PPD members who do not offer combo leagues or X01 specific leagues... it is necessary to allow a one-time conversion of their league MPR (Marks Per Round) to PPD (Points Per Dart) for participating in the tournaments. Players who meet the minimum 24 games of Cricket requirements, they convert MPR to PPD by multiplying their MPR (Marks Per Round) by 10 to determine their temporary PPD (Points Per Dart) for their first tournament entry.

EXAMPLE: Jane Smith plays in a Cricket only league, she has played 6 weeks and 24 games of Cricket. Her current Cricket MPR is 1.66. $1.66 \times 10 = 16.66$ PPD (Points Per Dart).

Note: *ONLY* sanctioned players in areas where *no X01 leagues are offered may use a converted Marks Per Round for their first tournament entry.* After a player has competed in an All-Star Series of Darts tournament, they will establish a tournament PPD (Point Per Dart), which will then be used for future tournament entry and ranking, providing they maintain their minimum 6 weeks of current league play.

Bonus Points... All-Star and Rising-Star players will receive four (4) Bonus Points each, for participating in the Singles Event, the Triples Event, the Mixed Doubles Event and the Handicapped Team Event. However, points are limited to a total of twelve (12) Bonus Points per each weekend.

Brackets... *Space and boards allow for four (4) brackets of 32 teams.* Officials reserve the right to adjust brackets according to entries received, i.e. add byes where necessary and to adjust payouts where necessary due to byes. Each bracket will have their own prize fund accordingly.

Name Tags... Your name tag will display your name, player ID number, operator, MPR, PPD, handicap and all of your entered events. Your name tag **MUST** be worn at all times during competition.

Score Sheets... A score sheet will be provided for each match of every round. It will contain all information related to a match, i.e. game format, shooting order, corking and starting each game. After each game, denote the MPR's and PPD's achieved by each player on both teams. After the match, the score sheet must be signed by both team captains and returned to the officials.

Call to a Match... During the tournament there is a first call, and if needed, a last call to a match. *Officials will begin the match five (5) minutes after last call.* If a player is not at the board when the match begins, team will forfeit the match. Once match play has started, **DO NOT LEAVE THE AREA**, you must stay in the tournament room. If you leave for any reason during a match, your team can be disqualified. Keep an eye on your teammates.

Do not practice on vacant boards during a match!!!

Failure to Show & Subs...After 5:00 pm on Thursday, prior to any tournament weekend, the team content is locked. If a team member is absent at the event, the team may use a sub. A sub will be assigned from any available subs at the event with a History/Current/Tournament MPR/PPD (whichever is highest) that is equal to or lower than the player that the team is missing. If a substitute is used in the Handicapped Team event, that player MUST shoot at the missing players designated handicap. Should no sub be available, the team must play short or forfeit. ***THERE ARE NO REFUNDS DUE TO THE 100% PAYBACK.*** Prize amounts are pre-calculated for posting.

Games...

- ♦ Cricket – round limit is 20...at round limit, the winner is based on total points unless points are tied...then total marks will decide the winner! IF, at the end of 20 rounds there is a tie for both points and marks, a game of “No-Score Cricket” must be played.
- ♦ All X01 games will be OI/OO.

Corking...*Flip a coin, winner of coin toss chooses to “see or show”.* Each team’s lowest person will cork. Game #1 – winner of cork will start the game. Game #2 – loser of Game #1 will start the game. Game #3...if needed – loser of Game #2 chooses to “see or show” the cork, the winner of the cork will start Game #3.

Corking and starting information for rounds four and five, due to added matches, is as follows:

Corking & Starting for Round 4 (race to four) - Flip a coin, winner of coin toss chooses to “see or show”.
Each teams lowest person will cork.

Game #1 – winner of cork will start the game. Game #2 – loser of Game #1 will start the game.
Game #3 – loser of Game #2 will start the game. Game #4 – loser of Game #3 will start the game.
Game #5 – loser of Game #4 will start the game. Game #6 – loser of Game #5 will start the game.

Game #7...if needed – loser of Game #6 chooses to “see or show” the cork, the winner of the cork will start game #7.

Corking & Starting for Round 5 (race to five) - Flip a coin, winner of coin toss chooses to “see or show”.
Each teams lowest person will cork.

Game #1 – winner of cork will start the game. Game #2 – loser of Game #1 will start the game.
Game #3 – loser of Game #2 will start the game. Game #4 – loser of Game #3 will start the game.
Game #5 – loser of Game #4 will start the game. Game #6 – loser of Game #5 will start the game.
Game #7 – loser of game #6 will start the game. Game #8 – loser of game #7 will start the game.

Game #9...if needed – loser of Game #8 chooses to “see or show” the cork, the winner of the cork will start game #9.

Added Matches...For the Singles, Triples, Mixed Doubles and Handicapped Team Events...matches have been added to the Winners Side as follows:

Round 4 – the four (4) undefeated players will play a race to four (4)
Round 5 – the two (2) undefeated players will play a race to five (5)
Round 6 – Championship Match will revert back to race to two (2)
Added matches will be on all score sheets.

NOTE: Please see back of score sheet for detailed corking and starting information for rounds four and five, due to added matches.

Section B – Singles Tournament

On Friday at EVERY All-Star Series of Darts Weekend.

Team Cap...There is no team cap...however, flights will be determined by History/Current/Tournament PPD – whichever is higher.

Section B – Singles Tournament – cont.

Entry Fees... \$20 per person. Fees are non-refundable. Entry fees are due at the time of submission. Entry will not be posted on the website until the entry fee is paid. Please make checks payable to All Star Series of Darts. Beware – checks must clear prior to the 2 week deadline. Money orders are accepted, same as cash. Credit cards via PayPal (plus fees).

NOTE: Entries are limited to four (4) brackets of 32 teams, totaling 96 men and 32 women.

Event Check-In begins at 9:00 am... players are required to be at the tournament site, identify themselves and receive name tags by **10:30 am deadline**. Tournament will start as soon as everyone has checked in or by **11:00 am at the latest**.

Format... MEN'S Singles - Added matches on Winners Side...please see Section A for complete details. Triple Elimination...Winners Side will be a race to two, Cricket; Survivors Side will be a race to two Cricket, with a tiebreaker of 501 and the Losers Side will be a race to two, 501. Game format is on all score sheets.

LADIE'S Singles - Added matches on Winners Side...please see Section A for complete details. Triple Elimination...Winners Side will be a race to two, Cricket; Survivors Side will be a race to two Cricket/501, with a tiebreaker of 301 and the Losers Side will be a race to two, 301. Game format is on all score sheets.

Section C – Triples Tournament

On Friday Night at EVERY All-Star Series of Darts Weekend.

Team Cap... Teams may consist of any combination of three sanctioned players whose History / Current / Tournament PPD – *whichever is highest* – when added together does not exceed 68.5 PPD. One (1) player per team may use the individual cap of 30 PPD. The purpose of this cap is to ensure everyone can participate, including top sanctioned players. NOTE: Although players may use the individual cap of 30 PPD, they are actually flighted and handicapped using their ACTUAL PPD.

Entry Fees... 10 per person/\$30 per team. Fees are non-refundable. Entry fees are due at the time of submission. Entry will not be posted on the website until the entry fee is paid. Please make checks payable to All Star Series of Darts. Beware – checks must clear prior to the 2 week deadline. Money orders are accepted, same as cash. Credit cards via PayPal (plus fees).

On Friday Night at EVERY All-Star Series of Darts Weekend.

Triple Elimination – Winners Side and Survivors Side will be a race to two, 501; Losers Side will be ONE (1) game of 701 Game format is on all score sheets.

Shooting Order...Lowest to Highest – Player C (the corker), Player B, Player A

Section D – Mixed Doubles Tournament

On Saturday Morning at EVERY All-Star Series of Darts Weekend.

Team Cap...Teams must contain one male and one female, whose History/Current/Tournament PPD – *whichever is highest* – when added together does not exceed 48.0 PPD. One (1) player per team may use the individual cap of 30 PPD. The purpose of this cap is to ensure everyone can participate, including top sanctioned players. NOTE: Although players may use the individual cap of 30 PPD, they are actually flighted and handicapped using their ACTUAL PPD.

Entry Fees...\$20 per person/\$40 per team. Fees are non-refundable. Entry fees are due at the time of submission. Entry will not be posted on the website until the entry fee is paid. Triple Elimination – Winners Side will be a race to two, 501/Cricket/501; Survivors Side will be a race to two, 501; Losers Side will be race to two, 301. Game format is on all score sheets.

Shooting Order...Lowest to Highest – Player B (the corker), Player A

Section E – Handicapped Team Event

On Saturday Night at EVERY All-Star Series of Darts Weekend.

Team Cap...Teams may consist of any combination of four players, whose History / Current / Tournament PPD – *whichever is highest* – when added together does not exceed 90 PPD. One (1) player per team may use the individual cap of 30 PPD. The purpose of this cap is to ensure everyone can participate, including top sanctioned players. NOTE: Although players may use the individual cap of 30 PPD, they are actually flighted and handicapped using their ACTUAL PPD.

**Please see Section A – Who is Eligible for more information on history/current/tournament PPD.*

Entry Fees...\$10 per person/\$40 per team. Fees are non-refundable. Entry fees are due at the time of submission. Entry will not be posted on the website until the entry fee is paid. Please make checks payable to All Star Series of Darts. Beware – checks must clear prior to the 2 week deadline. Money orders are accepted, same as cash. Credit cards via PayPal (plus fees).

Section E – Handicapped Team Event (cont)

On Saturday Night at EVERY All-Star Series of Darts Weekend.

NOTE: Entries are limited to four (4) brackets of 32 teams, totaling 128 teams.

Rising-Star Point Allotments – points will be awarded to every Rising-Star player according to the position they are eliminated from the triple elimination bracket...due to the need for different size rosters, be sure to check the chart at each event for actual point values.

Event Check-In begins at 1:30 pm... players are required to be at the tournament site, identify themselves and receive name tags by **3:00 pm deadline**. Tournament will start as soon as everyone has checked in or by **3:30 pm at the latest**.

Format – Added matches on Winners Side...please see Section A for complete details.

Triple Elimination – Winners Side will be a race to two, 501/Cricket/501; Survivors Side will be a race to two, 501; Losers Side will be race to two, 301. Game format is on all score sheets.

Handicap... Your name tag has a handicap printed on it...this is your handicap for the Team Event and you are required to shoot that number of darts in the first round of every game, of each match!

- For example...
 - The handicap is zero (0), you will get zero darts the first round
 - The handicap is one (1), you will get one dart in the first round
 - The handicap is two (2), you will get two darts the first round
 - The handicap is three (3), you will get all three darts the first round.

Shooting Order... Highest to Lowest – Player A, Player B, Player C and Player D (the corker).

Section F – How To Register

How To Register... Players MUST pre-register and submit their entry fee. Entries are limited to the first 96 Men and 32 Women for the Singles Event, 128 teams for the Triples, Mixed Doubles and Handicapped Team Events. Deadline for entries is fourteen (14) days prior to the tournament. You can register by using any of the following:

Section G – Player Conduct & Good Sportsmanship

Shooter's Advantage... A dart that sticks in a mark but does not register the mark will be manually scored by an official. A dart that “flights” a mark on the way in, but sticks elsewhere, will not be manually un-scored. The match must be stopped. All darts must be left exactly as thrown until verified and scored by officials. If the darts are removed, the score displayed will remain.

Section G – Player Conduct & Good Sportsmanship (cont)

Conduct... All player conduct at the tournament will follow all rules that pertain to regular league play including dart weights, poor sportsmanship, etc. Good Sportsmanship, common sense and ethics will dictate the resolution of any discrepancies. Negative behavior is not permitted!! We have a zero tolerance policy on any negative or over-zealous behavior!

No insults, cursing, aggressive or abusive behavior of any kind will be tolerated. Should you misbehave to the point that we must approach you about it, you are expected to immediately modify your behavior. If you do not comply with our request, you will be required to leave the premises. All future tournament privileges will depend upon your immediate compliance.

Upon tournament committee's discretion – any player misconduct will result in immediate expulsion from the tournament and premises...as well as future events and leagues.

The judgments of the officials at or following any event are final.
